Kingmoor Parish Council Highways complaint schedule July 2019

Complaints raised with Highways department – Current position obtained from HIMS and correspondence with Highways Department.

Reference number	Description	Current position
W1980950755	Due to the lack of maintenance since the construction of the CNDR roundabout, a drainage gutter at the base of the embankment next to Spa House has become blocked, causing highway drainage water to overflow onto a public footpath, which then flows into the CNDR underpass west of Spa House. The nearby Pow Beck also requires cleaning out, either side of the CNDR, to maintain field drainage. The septic tank overflow for Spa House empties into Pow Beck and will benefit from an unobstructed discharge.”	<p>Site visit has taken place – This is not the responsibility of CCC but connect roads – response below from County Council representative: - Thank you for contacting me and sending me a copy of the letter to the Environment Agency, I was contacted by one of Cumbria County Council's highway representatives in early March and subsequently carried out a site visit.</p> <p>Following my site visit I liaised with representatives of Connect Roads requesting some maintenance of the restricted outfall and had wrongly presumed that this had been duly actioned and completed and therefore apologies that this was not the case.</p> <p>Have now forwarded both e mails to representatives of Connect who will be in touch in the coming days.</p> <p>Connect will now progress accordingly, please let me know if there are any further issues / delays and I will action accordingly.</p> <p>Sincere apologies for the misunderstanding.</p>

W1980969927	<p>Request for advice</p> <p>“We recently contacted the Community Payback Team to ask them if they could do some work on the verges near the playground in Cargo and also on the pavements (cutting back the grass and vegetation which is starting to block the pavement). We had a site visit and were told that as both these pieces of work are next to the road we would have to ask you if they are able to do the work under section 7 as they do not have any public liability insurance.</p> <p>Have you come across other instances where the Community Pay Back Team have been asked to undertake work by a parish council adjacent to a Highway and if so how do we take this matter forward.”</p>	<p>Email acknowledge awaiting a further response.</p>
