Kingmoor Parish Council would like to know if the council can erect a directional sign (like a traditional finger post) that will point the way to Stainton Village, the CNDR roundabout and Etterby. W1980969927	Request for advice -Are the Community Payback Team able to cut the verges and clear the footpath in Cargo under section 7 as they do not have any public liability insurance.	Email acknowledged awaiting a further response.
W1980975185	Request for advice – Kingmoor Parish Council have paid to have the vegetation at the entrance to Cargo village at the junction with the CNDR to Rockcliffe road cut back due to a near miss. This is an ongoing issue which may need to be addressed again before the winter sets in.	Email acknowledged awaiting a further response.
