The bus service at Crindledyke is now running to the end of Fenwick Drive where it turns around.

The footpath Interpretation Board at Crindledyke is awaiting confirmation from Carlisle City Council and a new notice board is waiting for the contractor to erect it.

The pond at Stainton has been cleaned out and signage installed.

At Cargo, a footpath from the park to the bus-stop is to be built and we are waiting for the contractor to start.

The Council have asked about a footpath on the C1016 from Honey-pot Lane back towards Carlisle, running to the main entrance of Cargo. Councillor Allison took this up and has emailed Highways, a response is awaited.
